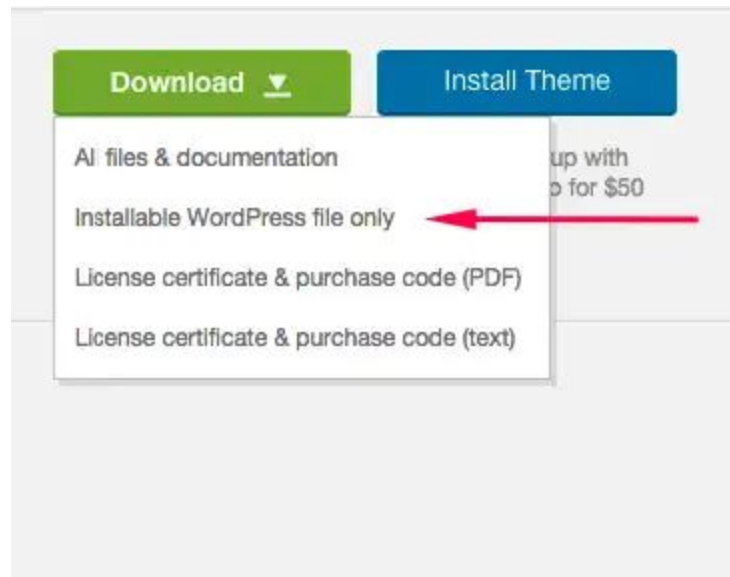

Installing the Theme

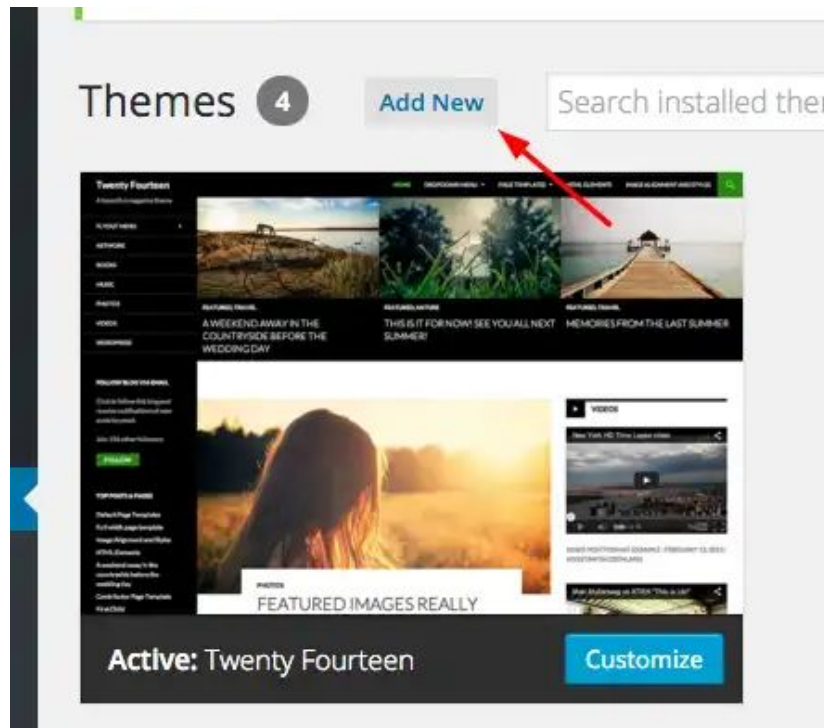
To install themes with the WordPress theme uploader:

1. In order to download the theme files package, please log in to [Themeforest](#). Navigate your mouse over your profile name, then go to the [Downloads](#) page. Click on the Download button and you will get a few options to download: All files & documentation; Installable WordPress file only; License certificate & purchase code (PDF); License certificate & purchase code (text). Click the **Installable WordPress file only** button.

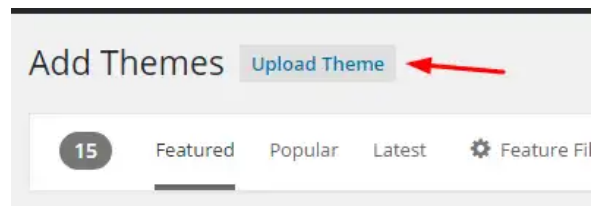


2. When you download the theme from Themeforest, you will get an archive file in .zip extension. When done, you should see a zip file called **hnd.zip**.
3. Login to your WordPress Dashboard.

4. Go to Appearance > Themes. Click Add New button, located at the top of the screen.



5. Continue by clicking **Upload Theme** and choose **hnd.zip**.

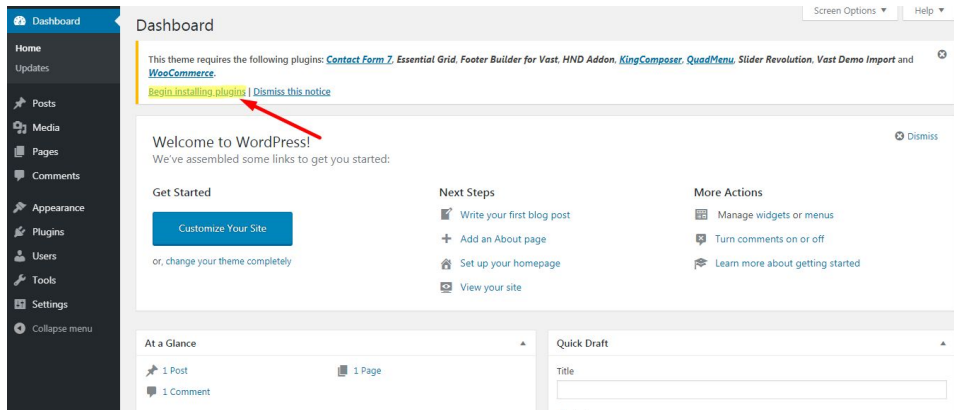


6. Wait until the theme is uploaded and installed, and then activate the theme when the installation finished.

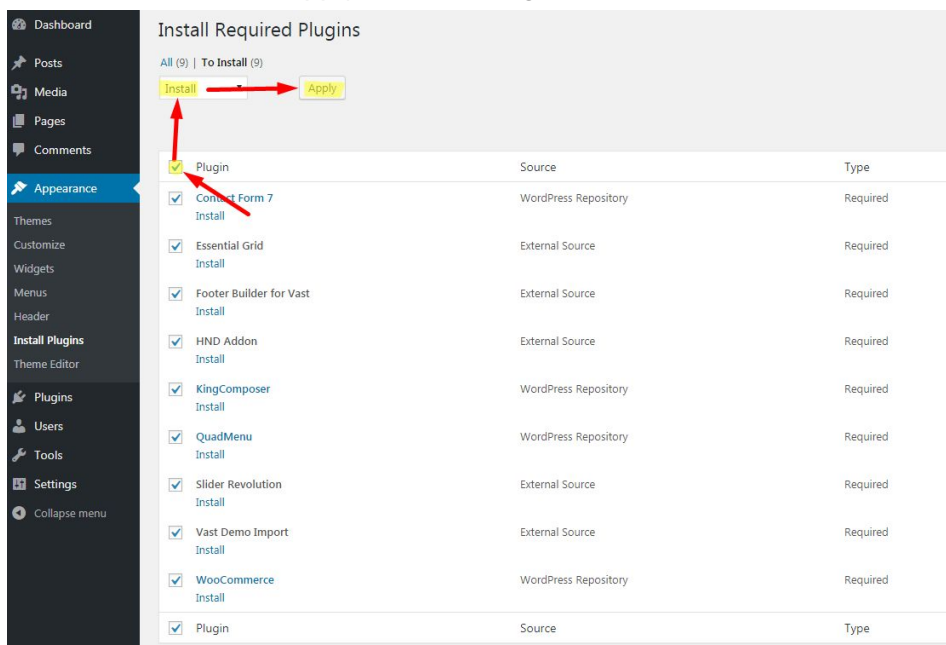


Required Plugins Installation

1. After finishing the theme installation, you will need to install required plugins, click on the "Begin Installing Plugins" button on the notification like this



- Click on the topmost tickbox from the list and then choose to "Install" on the drop-down menu and click on the Apply button to begin installation



- After the installation finished successfully, a notice will appear. Click on the "Return to Required Plugins Installer" and we're going to activate those plugins.

Importing Demo Content

If you are starting a fresh site, importing the demo content will help you understand how the theme demo is built. The Demo Import feature will import the contents (posts, pages, comments, etc.), H&D settings, menus, and widgets setup from our demo to your site.

Importing demo data allow you to quickly edit everything instead of creating content from scratch. It is recommended uploading sample data on a fresh WordPress install to prevent conflicts with your current content. You can use this plugin to reset your site if needed: [WordPress Database Reset](#)

There are several steps to import demo content, i.e.:

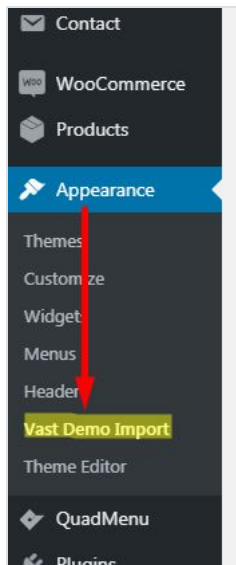
- 1) Import the Demo content.
- 2) Import the QuadMenu Options.
- 3) Import Essential Grid.
- 4) Update the Footer page.

We will explain each step in more detail as follows

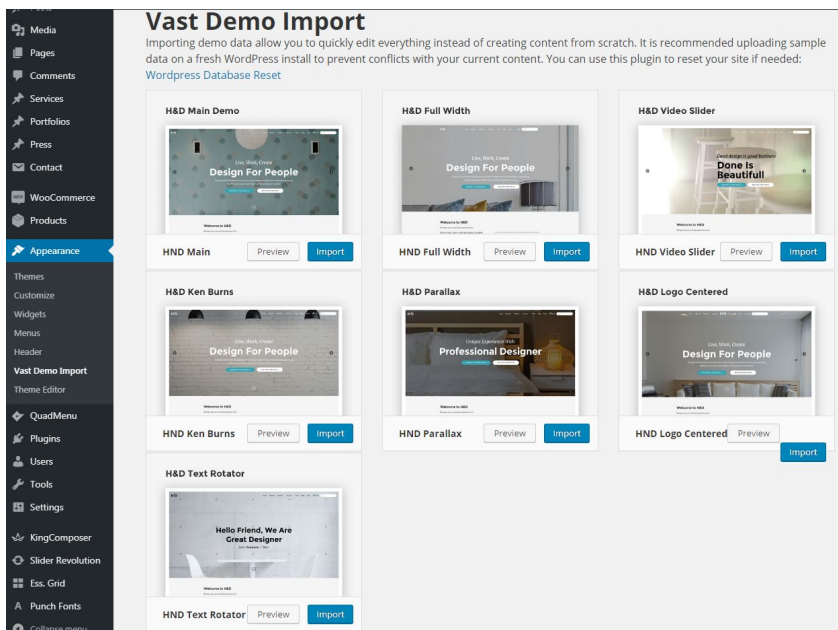
Warning, although importing demo will not remove your existing content. It is highly recommended for new installations only.

1) How to import the demo content:

1. Go to WP Admin > Appearance > Vast Demo Import.

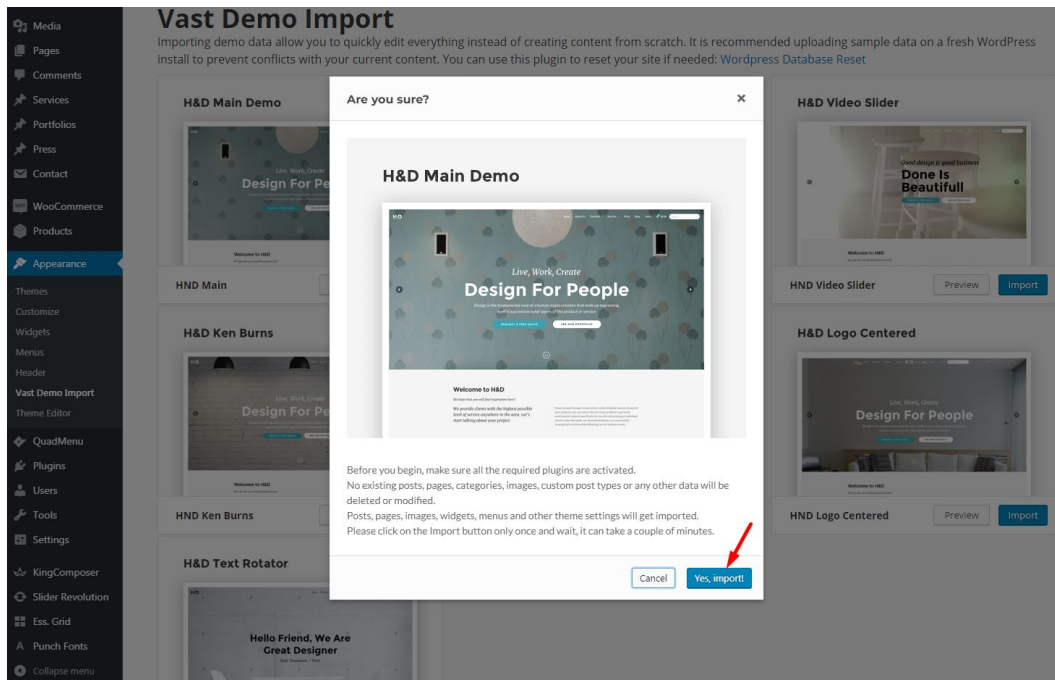


2. Click on the Import button from one of the templates you want to import (Note that the featured images maybe will be replaced with dummy images for copyright reasons)



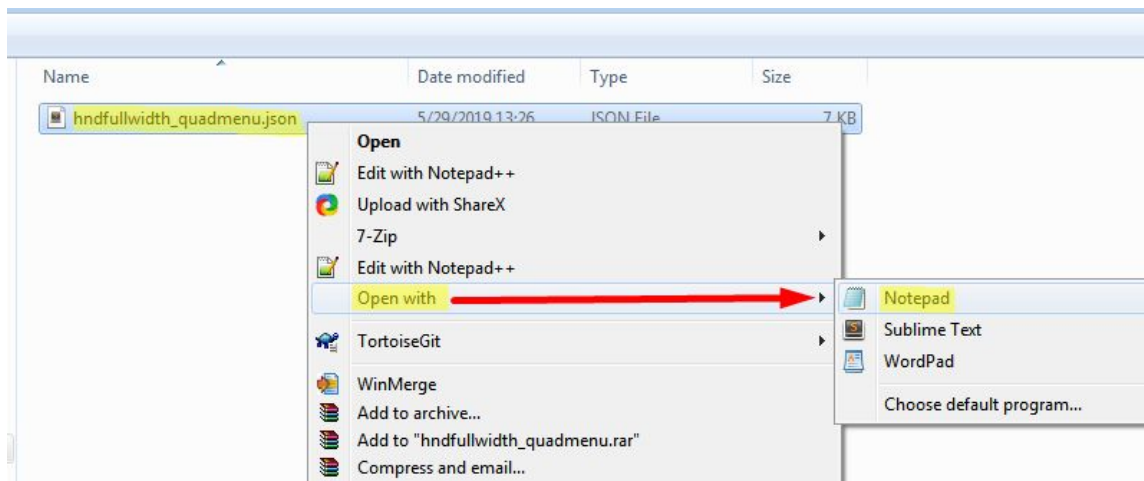
3. A popup will appear, make sure you've reset the contents of your site because if you haven't it will look bad after you've imported a template. Click on the "Yes, Import!" button

when you're ready to import

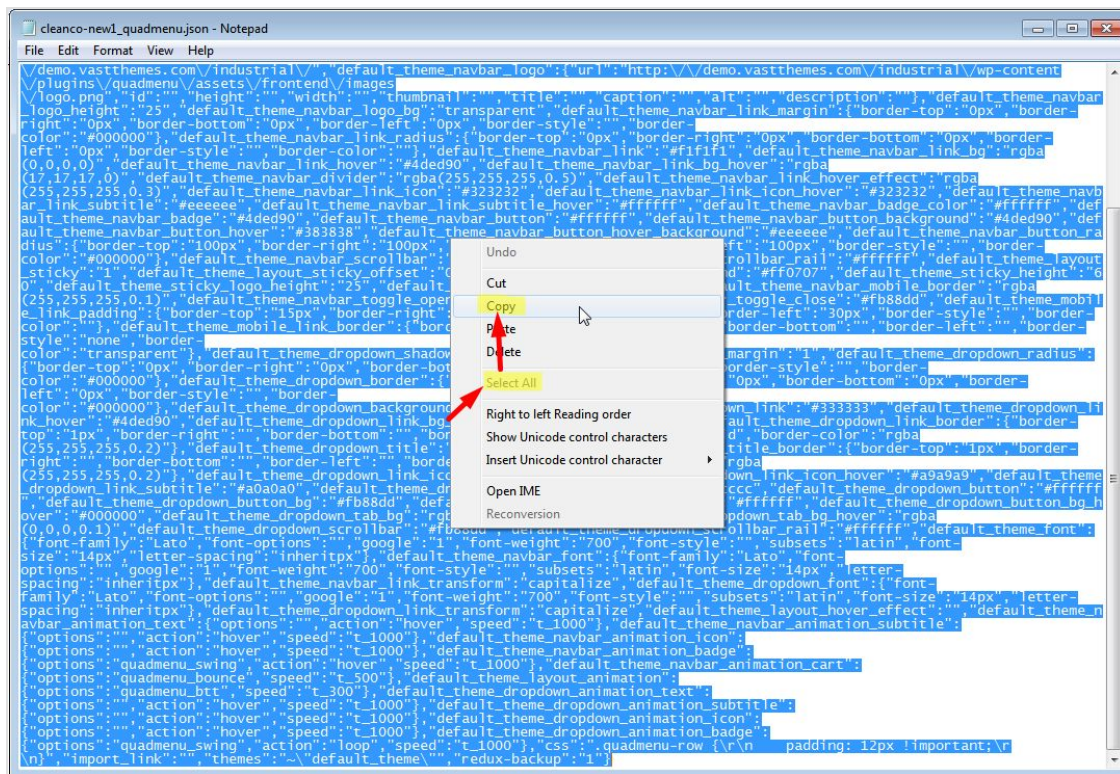


2) How to import the QuadMenu Options:

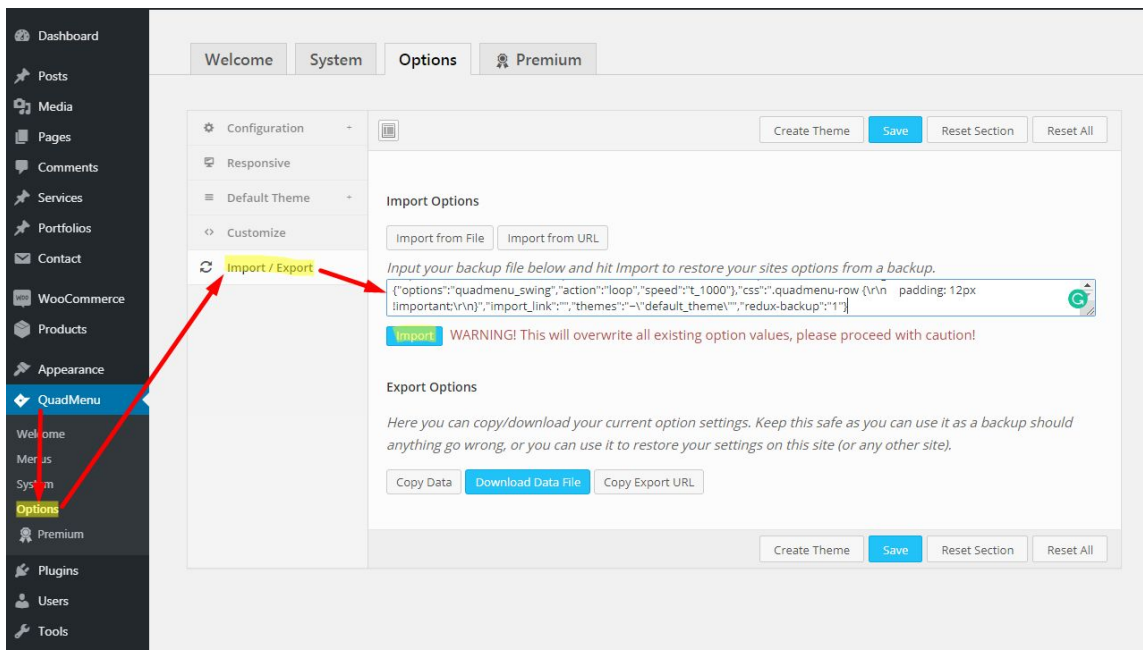
1. Find json files in the following folder "demo_import_files" > hnd demo # > quadmenu



2. Open json files with a text editor or notepad application then select all text then copy

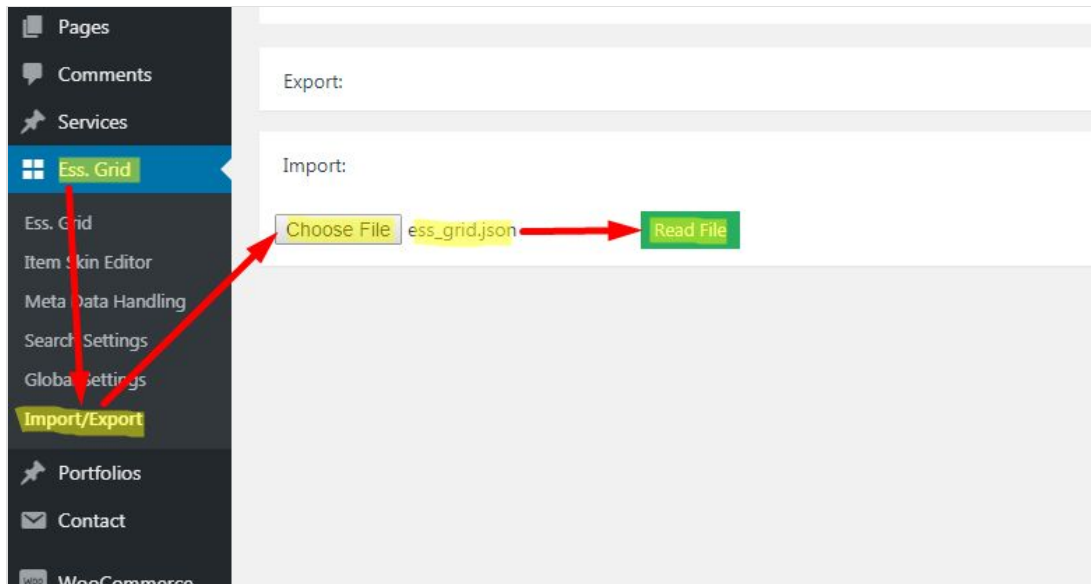


3. Then paste them in QuadMenu Options and then import

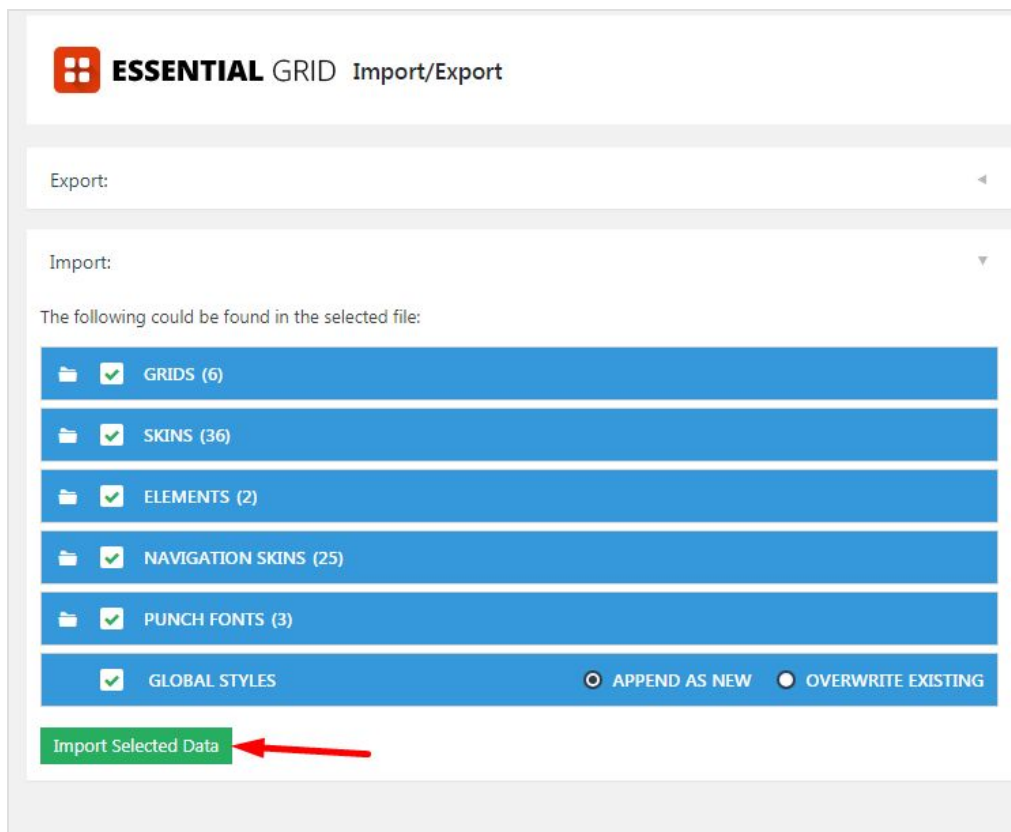


3) How to import Essential Grid:

1. Go to Ess. Grid > Import/Export, then select the `ess_grid.json` file in the following folder "demo_import_files" > hnd demo # > grids

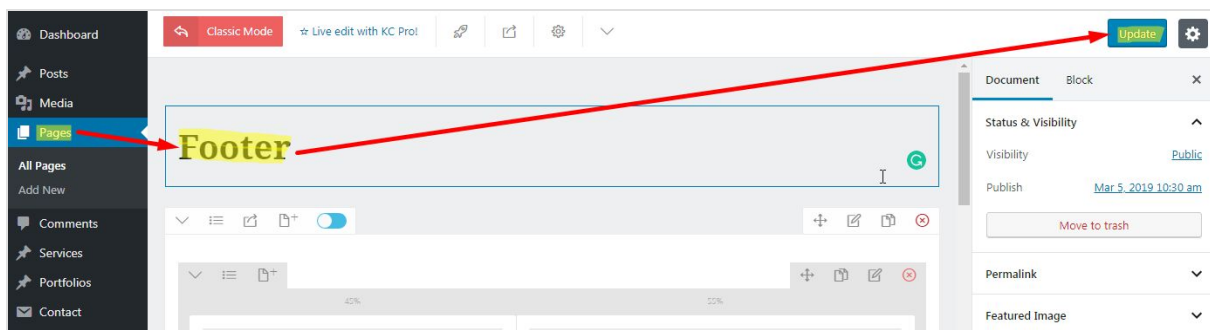


2. click the Import Selected Data button

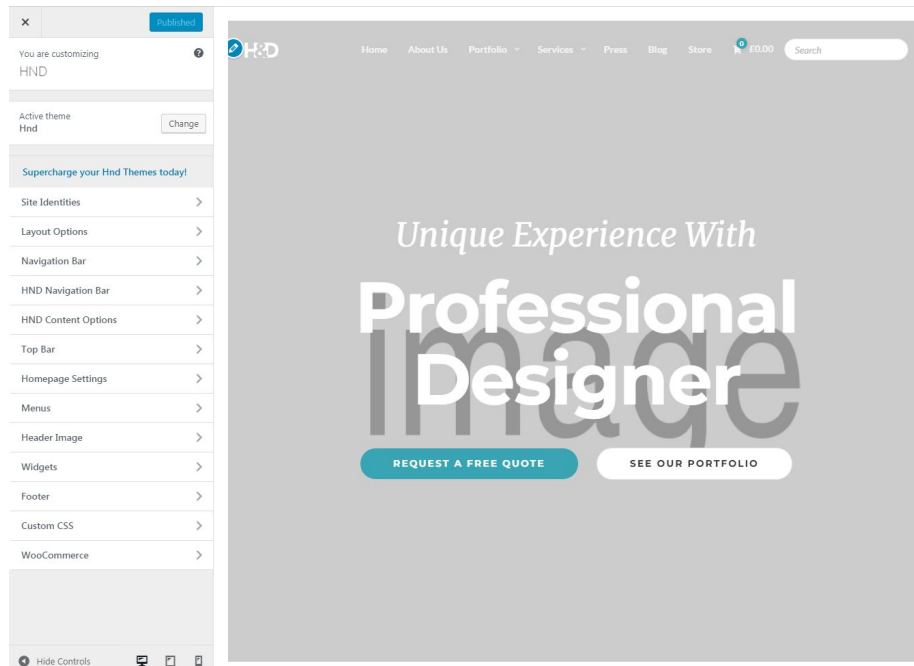


4) Update the Footer page

On several occasions, the Footer display is not as it should be. All you need to do is open the Footer page and update it to get the results according to the demo.



Theme Customizer



H&D theme allows you to customise most of the theme settings via WordPress' Customizer panel. Here are the customisation options available on H&D Theme as an addition to WordPress default Customizer options:

1. Site Identities
 - a. Logo
 - b. Site Title
 - c. Favicon
 - d. Brand Color
2. Layout Options
 - a. Blog Layout

This option allows you to choose between Fullwidth layout or Boxed layout on Blog Posts.
 - b. Layout Styles

This allows you to choose a classic layout or masonry layout on Blogs page.
 - c. Sidebar Option
 - d. Header Image Scrolling
 - e. Dropdown Style
 - f. Related Post Image
3. Navigation Bar
 - a. Navigation Position

- b. Font & Background Color
 - c. Font & Background Color Sticky
 - d. Bottom Border on Homepage
 - 4. H&D Navigation Bar, the theme can display a maximum of 3 Navigation info.
 - 5. H&D Content Options, the theme can enable or disable background.
 - 6. Top Bar, themes can display the top bar on the right and left side, can be displayed in text or HTML format.
 - 7. Footer, the theme can select widget or page to appear on Footer.
 - 8. And other standard WordPress features.
